Taw Wharf Development

Work is continuing on phase 4, The Longbridge Quarter of the Taw Wharf development in North Devon with Pearce Construction (Barnstaple) Limited.

Anchorwood Ltd was formed in June 2015 and is a commercial trading subsidiary company of North Devon Homes. It was created to ensure they could secure additional revenue within their group to invest in new affordable homes for local people.



The redevelopment of North Prospect has been underway for some time and during the last 10 years work on the scheme has helped transform an area of Plymouth. Phases 1, 2, 3 and 5 of this work have now been completed, and Phase 4 is underway, with completion due in 2024. Over the course of five phases, Plymouth Community Homes will have created 456 homes for affordable rent, 184 homes for shared ownership, and 450 homes for open market sale. The regeneration was deliberately planned to deliver a variety of house types, sizes and tenures in order to ensure a sustainably mixed neighbourhood for the future. Taylor Lewis is appointed for phases 2-5 and will assist Plymouth Community Homes to deliver the much needed regeneration of the area

Our Retrofit Team are currently working on five large "Turnkey" projects for the Abri Housing Group, these have been funded by the Government as part of the Social Housing Decarbonisation Fund (SHDF) Wave 2.1. The projects started in April 2023 and will run until March 2025. Four of the Five projects are Retrofit Assessments in and around Somerset. With more projects planned in the South West and South East over the next few years the Taylor Lewis Retrofit Team are delighted to have been earmarked for more schemes where

we will undertake the Retrofit Assessment and Coordination duties.









Maximising potential

Where were you born?
