A major new suburb in Cornwall

Working in partnership with Ocean Housing and Morrish Homes on the North coast of Cornwall. These properties are situated on the edge of the seaside town of Newquay, Nansledan is a major new suburb in Cornwall, and it has been developed by the estate of the Duchy of Cornwall. The development, officially described as 'an extension of Newquay', had the endorsement of King Charles III during his time as Duke of Cornwall.



Keyford Meadows, Frome

March saw handovers of these beautiful Frome postcode homes. Working in partnership with Curo and Curo Enterprises, Keyford Meadows will respond to the local demand for housing to deliver a mix of one and two bed apartments and two, three and four bed family houses, a proportion of which will be the part-buy/part-rent

scheme, shared ownership and affordable housing.



Manor Gardens, Frenchay

The TL Team are working as Employers Agent and Clerk of Works for Aequus Group and affordable housing provider, Alliance Homes Group. Thirty energy efficient family homes are being constructed in Frenchay, ranging from one to four bedroom properties. Eleven of the homes will be affordable, of which eight will be designated for social rent and three for shared ownership. The entire development will meet the energy efficiency standards as set out by the (AECB) Association for Environment Conscious Building.







Handovers in Exeter

New affordable shared ownership homes ready for handover on this Exeter development. Built by Linden Homes on behalf of our client Aster Group, these properties will soon be ready for move in dates.

New development in North Somerset

the edge of the North Somerset village and will offer high quality sustainable shared ownership and social rented housing.





The Grange in Goonhavern

Working in partnership with Westward Housing Group and Legacy Properties bringing much needed homes to the North Cornwall coast.

The Grange in Goonhavern provides six rental and three shared ownership homes, for local people complete with panoramic countryside views.



Rhondda Bowl and Fruit Warehouse

We were delighted to visit the Rhondda Bowl and Fruit Warehouse housing developments in April. Newydd Housing Association, in partnership with Rhondda Cynon Taf County Borough Council and contractors Castell Group, are developing thirty-four muchneeded affordable apartments and houses in the heart of Tonyrefail, Rhondda Cynon Taff. These homes, funded in part by the Welsh Government, hope to be completed in 2025.

Energy-efficient homes in Crumlin development

The much-needed affordable housing development, Ton Y Felin, boasts 60 energyefficient homes near Crumlin. This development consists of one-bedroom apartments and two and three-bedroom homes. Working in partnership with Pobl Group and M & J Cosgrove Construction Limited the homes were constructed using timber frame structures supplied by Celtic Offsite, a social enterprise of the United Welsh Group. Celtic Offsite also produced insulation for the structures at its Caerphilly factory.

Ton Y Felin is not only offering homes for rent, some properties are available for shared ownership and outright market sale.
