## Former ambulance station in Nelson

Residents have moved into five new 'energy efficient' bungalows, which have been built on the site of the former ambulance station in Nelson.

The two-bedroom bungalows were created using timber frames made within United Welsh's Celtic Offsite factory on Pontygwindy Industrial Estate, Caerphilly. Working alongside Caerphilly County Borough Council, the homes have been built with "high insulation", achieving a top energy efficiency rating. The whole development was funded through the Welsh Government's social housing grant.





# MMC Collaboration in Dorset and Wiltshire

We are currently working with Rollalong, a local offsite constructor, to provide high-quality modular homes.

These modern method of construction (MMC) homes help eliminate the gap between predicted and actual performance, has environmental benefits and provides a higher-quality final product. On site in Rowde to watch the delivery of the modules taking place.

This is one of multiple sites using MMC in Dorset and Wiltshire, and demonstrates what collaboration and partnership in the South West can achieve.











## New bungalows in Plympton

Working with Westward and Classic Builders on their latest housing development at St Peters Close, Plympton, providing five accessible and affordable bungalows, two shared ownership and three rental. The homes were provided with Homes England funding and recycled grant funding from Westward. The two two-bed bungalows for shared ownership and three one-bed bungalows for social rent are adaptable and accessible, with the larger one-bed bungalow being fully wheelchair accessible.



# **Energy Efficient homes in North Devon**

Our retrofit project with partners Westward Housing and Low Carbon Exchange continues in North Devon.

Enhancing the energy efficiency of homes through the options of new roofs, windows, doors, insulation, solar panels, renewable heating and improved ventilation systems, helping make homes more sustainable, warmer and cheaper for the individuals that live there.





### **Okement Park**

Newly completed homes were handed over in the autumn at the Okement Park development.

Working as Employers Agent with Legal & General Affordable Homes and developer Barratt Homes, Okement Park is a development of 1, 2, 3 & 4 bedroom homes on the edge of Okehampton. All homes benefit from bird boxes, bat boxes and bee bricks to support the local environment.











## More affordable homes in Ivybridge

Working again with Plymouth Community Homes and Bloor Homes to help deliver much needed, affordable housing developed through shared values of delivering quality housing for local people.

These homes will be located close to lyybridge town centre, with great access routes to the A38 and local primary and secondary schools. The rental and shared ownership sales will be available from Spring 2025.

### **Barne Barton**

The redevelopment of Barne Barton is progressing nicely with our clients Clarion Housing Group and Latimer by Clarion Housing Group.

Through major regeneration it will transform the 1960s estate to a modern community with high quality modern homes for everyone.















### **Connor Downs**
